2025 ALL-STATE MIDDLE SCHOOL SCALE LIMITS

(For the 7th and 8th grade All-State Band – auditioning in September of 2024 for the January 2025 FMEA Conference)

- Baritone Sax: Treble clef, C major, notes from B3 to B4.
- Trumpet in B \flat : Treble clef, B \flat major, notes from B \flat 3 to B \flat 4.
- Horn in F: Treble clef, F major, notes from F3 to F4.
- Trombone: Bass clef, C major, notes from B2 to B4.
- Euphonium: Bass clef, C major, notes from B2 to B4.
- Tuba: Bass clef, C major, notes from B2 to B4.

1. The required 7 major scales must be performed within the limits of the listed range and performed in complete octaves (*starting & ending with tonic pitches*).

2. Additional octaves "beyond" or "outside" of the designated ranges listed of the required 7 major scales will not be scored.

3. Percussionists should perform all major scales 2 octaves.
