General Information

The THS Performing Arts Center opened in January 2008 and seats 700 persons. The hall was designed as a concert hall and theatre and provides a professional performance venue to participating bands. The hall and stage have excellent acoustics. The stage will accommodate large bands and has a drop down ceiling (clouds) and choral shells along the sides. The adjudicators will be seated in the back of the hall. Most directors agree that it is best to set-up the band behind the proscenium.

Estimated Arrival Time and Guides

At least one week prior to the MPA, please email your estimated arrival time at THS to <u>terriersound@gmail.com</u>. We will have a guide assigned to your ensemble and they will be at your disposal throughout your time here.

Warm Up Room - Building 20

The Band Room will be used as the Warm Up Room. It is suggested that cases be left on busses or equipment trucks and that minimal equipment be taken into the building 20. Large equipment (percussion) will need to be loaded directly into the stage loading area from the loading dock on the east side of the theater.

FBA Office – PAC Annex

The FBA office and is located in the annex on the northwest side of the PAC. Your guide will show you how to find this room. Your adjudicator sheets and school packets will be available in this room after your performance. We will also provide refreshments in this room. Participating Bands should check in at the FBA Office immediately upon arrival.

Concession Information

Concessions will be provided from the start of MPA until the conclusion of MPA. Concession information will be available prior to the MPA. We kindly ask that bands patronize our concessions during the course of their visit to Titusville High School.

Bells (1) (This bell set includes a pedal dampening system)

Piano (1- Grand 9' Boston) *Please be sure to request this via e-mail or phone call no later than the week before the first day of MPA.*

Items such as Cymbals, Concert Snare, Toms, Triangle, Tambourine, and similar auxiliary and accessory percussion, sticks, and mallets ARE NOT provided and must be provided by the INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL. Also we will not provide any electronic keyboard or amplifier. Titusville High School is not responsible for providing or loaning any percussion or equipment other than that listed above.

Schools bringing their own equipment will need to unload at the loading dock door at least 1 band before you perform. Equipment must be removed immediately after the performance. Please let us know if you will be bringing your own percussion equipment so we can make sure to have someone at the door to meet you.

The following is provided in the warm-up room:

Chairs & Stands

Percussion equipment is not provided in the warm up room.

NOTE: The warm-up room seats large bands well but it is recommended that you bring in a limited amount of equipment. Please leave all cases on your busses or in your equipment truck to the extent possible.

Bus, Equipment Truck, and Spectator Parking:



Please enter the campus from US1 at the stop light (this is where Google Maps and other mapping software will direct you.) It is the only stoplight in front of the school. Once you enter the parking lot simply turn right (north) and drive to the theater to unload students.

The circle in front of the Performing Arts Center is for **unloading only.** The bus and equipment trailer parking is in the grassy area in the southeast of the parking lot (Please see map). If we run out of room in this area we will have people available to direct buses to the overflow parking. Personal vehicles may park immediately in front of the theater.

***Note: The parking lot will be quite crowded from 3:30-4:00 PM on Thursday and 2:15-2:45 pm on Friday. due to school dismissal traffic. **Please plan to arrive before or after this time.**
