2019-2020 ALL-ŠTATE HIGH SCHOOL JAZZ BAND AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

1. All-State Jazz Band membership rules and regulations:

- a) The student must be in the ninth, tenth, eleventh or twelfth grade.
- b) The decision of the selection committee is final.
- c) Only instruments listed on the All-State Application or in the 2019-2020 All-State Jazz Band Requirements printed in the handbook may audition.
- d) The student must be a member of the band program at their school and have their name submitted on the proper All- State Application form. The Application form must be completed through MPA Online and signed by the band director and principal. The Application form must be submitted by the deadline date set by the District.
- The band director must be a member of FBA/FMEA by September 1, 2019. e)
- Students selected for any All-State group must bring their own music stand, equipment, instrument(s), mutes etc. f)

2. All-State Jazz Band General Information:

- a) The improvisation materials are selected from the Jamey Aebersold series.
- b) All rhythm (Piano, Bass, Drum Set, Guitar) exercises are etudes written expressly for the FBA High School Jazz audition. (With the exception of the Drumset Excerpt "Say What" from Music Minus One Drummer The New Revised Edition)
- All wind (Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone) exercises are etudes written expressly for the FBA High C) School Jazz audition.

3. All-State Jazz Band Audition Requirements for Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone and Piano, Guitar and Bass. When the student enters the room, he/she will be asked to perform:

- The specific prepared exercises for their instrument as shown in the All-State Jazz Band a) Requirements. Performers should use appropriate jazz articulation (not necessarily indicated).
- Lead Trumpet This audition will be part of the regular section trumpet audition as an optional third audition etude, b) however the student must also perform the etudes for section trumpet. NOTE: The Lead Trumpet audition will only require one audition entry code. Students will perform all three etudes under the single code. In order to be considered for lead, the student must be entered as a Lead Trumpet.
- + Optional Improvisation will be two choruses of "Fast Blues in F" from Jamey Aebersold's Volume 2 Nothin' But c) Blues AND students will play the melody to "Stella by Starlight" then improvise one full chorus (Track 2) from Jamey Aebersold's Volume 22 "Favorite Standards"

Improvisation is mandatory if you wish to be considered for a solo chair. + Bass Players will walk a bass line first time, then improvise a second chorus of "Fast Blues in F" from Jamey Aebersold's Volume 2 Nothin' But Blues AND play a bass line first time to "Stella by Starlight" then improvise

- one full chorus of "Stella By Starlight" (Track 2) from Jamey Aebersold's Volume 22 "Favorite Standards". d) Doubling (Saxophones Only.) After improvisation on main instrument students will improvise two choruses of "Fast
- Blues in F" from Jamev Aebersold's Volume 2 Nothin' But Blues AND the melody to "Stella by Starlight" then improvise one full chorus of "Stella by Starlight" (Track 2) from Jamey Aebersold's Volume 22 "Favorite Standards".
- Sight-reading exercise to demonstrate the student's reading ability. The student will have thirty seconds e) to study the piece before playing it.

4. All-State Jazz Band Audition Requirements for Drum Set. When

the student enters the room, he/she will be asked to perform:

- The prepared exercises for drum set listed below. a)
- The indicated number of measures in the four different styles listed below to demonstrate steady time keeping and b) rhythmic creativity. They should imagine themselves in a jazz combo situation backing a horn soloist.

1.Rock (16 bars) quarter note = 76 2.Bossa Nova (16 bars) quarter note = 120 3.Swing (32 bars) quarter note = 144 4. Jazz Samba (32 bars) guarter note = 100

- a) Drummers will play the first portion of "Say What" pg 32-33 from For Drummers Only: Jazz Band Music Minus One Drummer (New Digitally Remastered Edition) Disc B, Track 6, (up to 1:22 mark on CD) measure 61
- Sight-reading exercise to demonstrate the student's reading ability. The student will have thirty seconds a) to study the piece before playing it.
