AGREEMENT FOR ADJUDICATOR SERVICES (revised 6/2020) 2020-2021 FBA DISTRICT XX MPA

This letter of agreement is entered into this <u>CONTRACT DATE</u> by and between <u>DISTRICT XX of the Florida</u> <u>Bandmasters Association</u> (hereinafter referred to as the "Agency"), and <u>FBA Board Approved Adjudicator</u> (Adjudicator).

1. The Adjudicator shall, in a satisfactory and proper manner as determined by the Agency, perform the following services:

- Attend an Adjudicator's Meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of the Music Performance Assessment (MPA) event.
- Adjudicate in the category of ______, understanding that the District Chair retains the right to modify this category as MPA needs dictate.
- Shall uphold the standards of adjudication as set forth in the Adjudicator Manual of the Florida Bandmasters Assoc.

2. Adjudicators are expected to maintain their FBA Board Approval status by attending renewal seminars every 5 years. This contract shall become void if the Adjudicator's Board Approval Status should lapse in the time between signing of, and execution of, this contract.

3. The Adjudicator shall commence performance of the agreement on <u>MPA Start Date</u> and shall complete performance of lthe agreement on <u>MPA Completion Date</u>.

4. The Agency shall furnish the following services and information to the Adjudicator:

- Adequate facilities and materials.
- Final bulletins concerning the details of the MPA.
- Housing and transportation to the MPA site (if needed). Housing needs will be requested by the District Chair or their authorized representative no later than one month prior to the start of the MPA.

5. The Adjudicator shall sign an expense voucher indicating expenses incurred and honorarium received to assure proper accounting for all funds and performance under the agreement.

6. The Adjudicator will be compensated as stated in the FBA Handbook or Adjudicator Manual, including honorarium, meal allowance, travel, and other expenses. **Mileage shall be based on the current IRS rate**.

7. Method of payment will be by Agency check for the full amount agreed upon, and shall be paid by mail during the week following the MPA.

8. The Agency shall provide the Adjudicator with fourteen (14) days' written notice, prior to a scheduled engagement, of a cancelation. If a cancelation is made with less than 14 days' written notice, unless due to a catastrophic event, the Agency shall be liable for the entire Adjudicator honorarium and travel fees, if applicable.

9. If the Agency cancels an engagement due to a catastrophic event, the Agency shall be liable based on the following schedule:

- If canceled the day of the engagement, 100% of honorarium and travel shall be paid;
- If canceled within 24 hours prior to, but not on the day of the engagement, 50% honorarium and 100% of applicable travel reimbursement shall be paid by the Agency;
- If canceled within 14 days prior to the engagement and prior to Adjudicator travel, no honorarium shall be paid and only non-refundable travel will be reimbursed.

A "catastrophic event" shall include, but not be limited to, an act of God, act of nature (including any epidemic or outbreak of pandemic disease), storm, flood, earthquake, fire, act of government or state, war, civil commotion, insurrection, embargo, labor disputes, and any other situation or event out of the reasonable control of the Agency. 10. This agreement must be returned or signed electronically within 14 days of the above date or the said agreement will be considered void.
