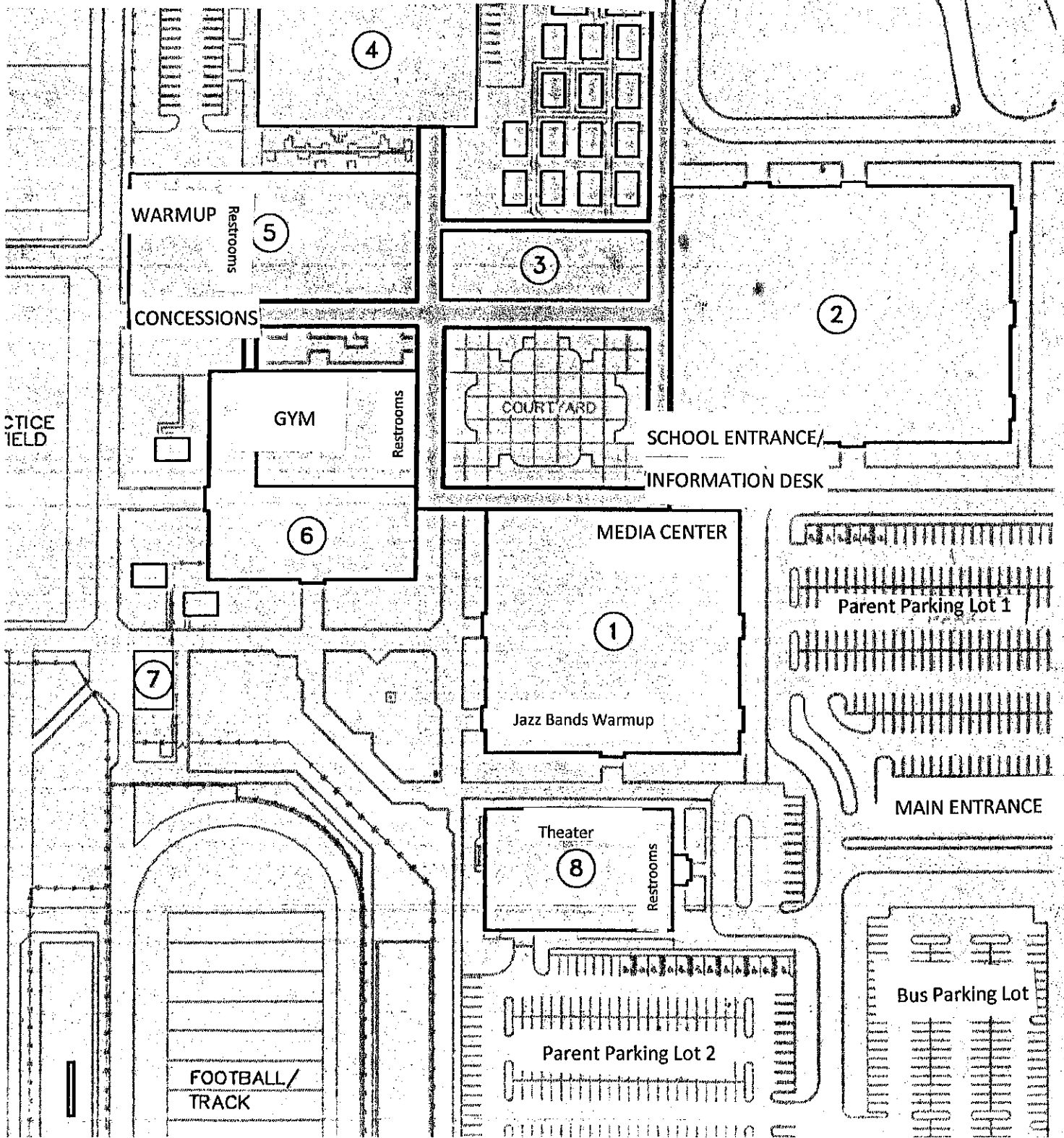
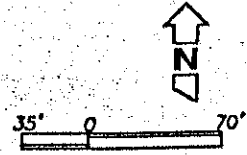

GENERAL INFORMATION

FBA Office

The FBA Office is in the Media Center, Building 1 (see enclosed map). Directors must sign in at the FBA Office prior to their school's first event. The Wolverine Band Boosters will provide light snacks for directors here.

Concessions Information

Concessions will be sold from the start of MPA until the conclusion. Concession menus are enclosed. Please support the host school's concession stand, as this is the only financial benefit for hosting this huge event.

***For large groups, directors are asked to fill out the Concessions PreOrder Form (on the FBA Website) to ensure we have enough food on hand (advance payment is not required).** We accept cash, credit cards, and Apple Pay at the event.

Warmup Areas

Musician Solos and Ensembles = Cafeteria, Building 5 (see enclosed map.) Students must refrain from playing instruments in any other areas. Percussionists should bring practice pads for warmup.

Auxiliary Solos and Ensembles = Courtyard or any other outdoor areas (see enclosed map.) Auxiliary may not warm up inside any buildings. In case of rain, utilize the covered outside walkways

Jazz Bands = Building 1 classroom to be determined (see enclosed map). Chairs, stands, and a piano will be provided in the warmup room.

Parking and Entry to Campus

All 3 campus parking lots will be available for parking (see enclosed map). All vehicles enter through the Main Entrance (see enclosed map, look for Wellington High School sign). Buses should park in the designated Bus Parking Lot (see enclosed map, on the southeast side of campus).

All participants must enter campus through the School Entrance as shown on map, in between Buildings 1 & 2.

Facility

All Auxiliary events will be held in the Gym, Building 6 (see enclosed map).

Equipment Requirements

All color guards must provide their own vinyl floor. All auxiliary events must adhere to all Inspection Requirements as listed in the FBA Handbook before being allowed to perform.

Sound System

Before Warmup

-Large equipment can be loaded from the back-stage door ramp (see enclosed map, located on the Football Stadium side of the Theater).

-Take your adjudicators' scores to warmup with you; a WHS student will take them to the adjudicators before your performance.

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO WELLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL

*****ALLOW EXTRA TIME FOR SOUTH FLORIDA TRAFFIC, AND WATCH THE SPEED LIMIT ESPECIALLY IN EQUESTRIAN AREAS*****

From North, West or East:

State Road 80 can be accessed from I-95, FL Turnpike, and State Road 7/US 441.

Take State Road 80 (Southern Blvd) to Forest Hill Blvd. Go South on Forest Hill Blvd .6 mile to Wellington Trace. Turn Right on Wellington Trace (west) and go 1.6 miles to Greenview Shores Blvd. Turn Left on Greenview Shores Blvd (south) and go .9 mile to Wellington High School on the right.

All vehicles enter through Main Entrance, look for school sign. All buses turn left to enter the Bus Parking Lot. Cars can turn right for Parking Lot #1, or left for Parking Lot #2.

From South:

State Road 802 (Lake Worth Rd) can be accessed from FL Turnpike and State Road 7/US 441.

Take State Road 802 (Lake Worth Rd) West to South Shore Blvd and turn right (north). Take South Shore Blvd 1.4 miles to Greenview Shores Blvd. Turn Left on Greenview Shores Blvd (north) and go .5 mile to Wellington High School on the left.

All vehicles enter through Main Entrance, look for school sign. All buses turn left to enter the Bus Parking Lot. Cars can turn right for Parking Lot #1, or left for Parking Lot #2.
