WHAT IS IT?

In its simplest terms, the STATE BAND MPA is an Evaluation/Assessment. Contrary to some popular misconceptions, the FBA MPA's are not contests or competitions, in which "losers" are automatically created. Every band has the opportunity to be recognized for whatever level of achievement is attained: superior, excellent, good, fair or poor, without depriving others of that recognition if they earn it. All performances are rated against a specific pre-set standard of excellence, and are evaluated by highly competent, reputable and experienced music professionals. In many ways it is true "accountability" and is highly reliable since the procedures, standards and means of evaluation have developed and evolved over a period of 80 + years.

WHAT DO THE RATINGS MEAN?

Ratings are earned, and written, as well as verbal comments given, for each performance based on the standards mentioned above as they are applied to the particular performance on the day and at the time the performance is heard. While these ratings offer some evidence as to the musical progress and development of the performing group, they are obviously not the only valid evaluation available. The group may have had an unusually good or bad day, caused by any number of variables. Consequently, one should not place undue emphasis on the ratings. While a "Superior" rating does represent a significant accomplishment, a rating of less than a "Superior" certainly does NOT indicate failure. Just being a part of the State Band MPA is a remarkable distinction for any group. It can (and should!) be a substantive educational experience if students (and directors and parents) hear outstanding musical performances from schools in other areas of the state, and if they use the evaluative comments by the adjudicators wisely and for the purpose for which they are intended.

WHAT IS THE FLORIDA BANDMASTERS ASSOCIATION?

The FBA, founded in 1936, is a professional educational association incorporated under the laws of Florida. It has over 1500 members who comprise over 95% of the instrumental music teachers in Florida from college through elementary levels. The organization is principally supported by individual member's dues and exists for the benefit of its members, their students, and for the promotion of quality music instruction and musical performance in our state and nation. The Association sponsors numerous activities for young people throughout the school year that provide positive and worthwhile outlets for their creative, expressive, physical and aesthetic energies, helping to enhance their quality and perspective of life both now and in future years.
