FBA Office

The FBA Office for all events is located in the Main Building, Room 106.

The FBA Office is for adjudicators and directors only. Drinks and snacks will be available for directors throughout the day.

Traveling From Out of Town

If you are traveling from out of town, the morning of the event, the City of Tallahassee has their Springtime Tallahassee parade, which closes down main roads in downtown Tallahassee typically from around 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. with traffic getting backed up for about an hour or so after the roads have reopened. Therefore, we recommend taking the following route to avoid potential delays:

From West of Tallahassee:

- 1. Take I-10 East and exit at Exit 203.
- 2. At the light, go straight onto Raymond Diehl Road and proceed for 0.3 miles.
- 3. At the light, turn right onto US-319 (Capital Circle NE) and proceed south for 3.4 miles.
- 4. At the light, turn right on to US-90 (Mahan Drive) and proceed west for 3 miles
- 5. The main entrance to Leon High School will be on the right.

From East of Tallahassee:

- 1. Take I-10 West and exit at Exit 209A.
- 2. Take US-90 (Mahan Drive) west for 7.4 miles
- 3. The main entrance to Leon High School will be on the right.

Parking

Refer to the maps on pages 9 (full campus map) and 10 (Main Building map) of this packet.

All parking is on a first come, first served basis and is free of charge, including onstreet parking around the campus.

Buses

All band buses can drop off band students in front of the Main Building by entering at the School Entrance. Buses can then park in the Junior Bowl.

Equipment Vehicles

Band equipment vehicles can enter via the bus ramp entrance (just west of the main School Entrance) to unload equipment. Equipment vehicles can then park in the Junior Bowl or Senior Bowl.

Attendees/Audience Vehicles

Attendees/audience members can park in a variety of locations:

- In front of the Main Building by entering at the School Entrance
- In the Senior Bowl (entrance on Terrace Street, just off of Tennessee Street)
- In the Dirt Bowl (entrance on Miccosukee Road)
- Along the street in the marked parking spots on Tennessee Street (school side, westbound traffic side)
- Along the street in the marked parking spots on Miccosukee Road (school side, northeastbound traffic side)

If you park in the Senior Bowl, you will have to climb three sets of 18 steps to the Main Building parking lot as well as the stairs up to the entrance of the Main Building.

Concessions

Concessions will be available in the area between the Main Building and the gym.

Available concessions will be hot dogs, chips, candy, and bottled water and soft drinks.

For large groups (e.g., Jazz Band, Auxiliary, etc.), consider pre-ordering a meal. The pre-order form is the last page of this packet.

Jazz MPA

Jazz MPA will take place in the Leon Performing Arts Theater, which is in the Main Building straight ahead when you enter the Main Building's main entrance. Jazz warmup will take place in the Media Center (in the Main Building, first floor).

Northwest Site Jazz Band Directors,

We are excited to host you and your band at the Northwest State Jazz MPA! Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a band guide who will help you logistically prepare for your performance. Your band guide will take you to Jazz Band case storage, which will be in a side room connected to the cafeteria. The warmup room is the Media Center and will be open to you 30 minutes before your performance time. From there, you will follow your band guide to the auditorium for your performance. When the performance is finished, your band guide will take you back to Jazz Band case storage.

In the warmup room, we will have a keyboard, drum set, chairs, and stands readily available. There are plenty of outlets for your rhythm section in warm up, but you will need to provide your own amplifiers, guitars, and basses. On stage, we will have a grand piano, keyboard, and drum set available upon request; however, none of them will be mic'd. There will also be two (2) solo microphones available in monitors that you can control on stage via a mixing board. Anything you want amplified aside from the soloists needs to be provided by you. For the winds, we have risers available as well as chairs and stands. We have enough risers to cover 8 feet deep by 16 feet wide on stage for the brass.

Auxiliary MPA

Auxiliary MPA will take place in the gym.

Performance Space (Gym)

The gym floor will be covered with a red floor protector. Groups that have their own floor are welcome to set up their floor on top of the preexisting floor protector.

We will have a sound system set up in the back of the gym to play your performance music.

Warmup Areas

There are several areas to warm up outside of the gym. Students are encouraged to find a grassy area on the campus where they can spin and warm up. For larger team practices, we encourage you to use our football field (made of artificial turf) to give you enough room to work.

Changing Rooms

There will be access to a dressing room, but please note that it is on a different floor from the performance area. There are also more easily accessible restrooms on the main floor. It should be noted that these restrooms are the same restrooms that the audience can use.

Solo & Ensemble MPA

With the exception of percussion, all solo and ensemble performances will take place in the Main Building. A map will be provided of the performance rooms when you arrive.

Warmup will be in the cafeteria (in the Bain Building), which is also the location of case storage.

Percussion Solos and Ensembles




Please plan to bring any additional percussion instruments with you that we do not have on the list as well as all sticks, mallets, etc., that your students will need.
