This is a large school with two campuses (main campus and a 9th grade center)

All Events will be on the Main campus.

Two roads surround Seminole (Ridgewood Ave. and Georgia Ave.)

Where you should park, depends on what your event is. See map on the next page.

Options:

Bus Parking - Is accessible from Ridgewood Ave. Bus parking is the loop in front of the school (near our flag pole).

General Parking for Solos and Ensembles - Preferred parking for students and parents. It is accessible from Georgia Ave. Go past the auditorium. Go past the cafeteria, and pull into a parking lot near our cafeteria (we call this parking lot the CTE parking lot).

Overflow General Parking - Parents and students can park near the auditorium or next to the front of the school (pool parking lot). **Please Do Not park in the loop** so we can save that space for buses.


Truck and Trailer Parking (Percussion and Jazz). If you have a truck that is pulling band equipment, please park behind the cafeteria on the Georgia Ave. side of the school. This parking lot is next to the auditorium and CTE lot and it does have a separate entrance.

Guard Parking and Trailer Parking (for guard) - Senior Parking Lot - North end of the football field. This is the easiest access to our two gyms. Cars please park in spaces. Trucks and Trailers park along the curb next to the football stadium. Type Sports Field, Seminole HS into AppleMaps or Bill Vogel Gymnasium, Seminole HS in Google Maps.

Judges/VIP/Directors Parking: Please park in the KWC Lot (auditorium). Type Karen W. Coleman performing arts building Seminole High School, it will take you to the Georgia Ave. side of the campus.
